



CCFRB - New Referees Course 2012

New Referees are required to attend a 2 day workshop which covers all aspects of becoming a Central Coast Football referee and culminates in a written examination comprising multiple choice questions. A successful pass in the written exam moves our new Referee applicants onto the Practical Day, where you will be taken to view a match with a designated CCFRB Mentor to analyse rules and regulations given by the Referees on the pitch. Following successful completion of the Referees Workshop, written exam and Practical day, you will be designated a Development Officer for your first 2 years on the pitch. All applications and payments must be received as per details below, to ensure your CCFRB accreditation.

General Information:

- You can be any age to sit the course however you will not be eligible to referee a match until you have turned 14. It is important to note also that if you do not referee a game for a year, you must re-sit the course.
- Make sure you arrive at the venue at least 15mins prior to course commencement to get your name marked off. Failure to do so will mean that you will not be able to participate in the course.
- You will need to bring a pen, notebook and water; light snack refreshments will be provided.
- The exam will consist of multiple choice questions from the Laws of the Game Handbook. Everyone will receive one of these at the beginning of the course and you will be taught the laws by one of our experienced education officers.

- When you pass the written exam you will be required to attend a practical day where you will watch a game at Plum Park with your mentor. More information will be given to you on the course date.
