#### SUMMARY

- Another round of high scoring matches has seen 30 goals scored for the second time in the three rounds of the Battlewin Mens Premier League competition. Two Saturday night matches saw both of the 2015 grand finalists beaten with Terrigal United pulling off a shock win over defending league champions Gosford City and Berkeley Vale downing premiers The Entrance. The biggest news however was a new Premier League individual goal scoring record with a magnificent seven from Killarney District's star striker Tim Knight.
- Fifth round FFA Cup matches will be played this week. On Wednesday night (20 April) The Entrance will be at home at Pat Morley Oval against NPL3 club Hawkesbury City; and Killarney District having the toughest task against NPL2 club Mount Druitt. Berkeley Vale are away to State League opponents St George FA on Thursday night.

#### **GOSFORD CITY vs TERRIGAL**

- In the biggest upset of the season, indeed arguably the biggest for many seasons, Terrigal have defeated Gosford City 5-2 in a fast-paced and exciting match at Pluim Park on Saturday night. The game looked like following its predicted path when Adam Woodbine scored for Gosford in the 10th minute. Instead it acted as a spur to the Terrigal side, beaten badly in their first two matches, who equalised in the 29th minute from a free kick on the edge of the box by skipper Anthony Pace. That goal gave the confidence boost that the young team needed and the game was evenly-contested. Terrigal took the lead from a brilliant 30-metre drive from Jayden Priest but that was cancelled out by Graham Toope 10 minutes later. The match then swung decisively in favour of the underdogs in the 77th minute with a second goal to Man of the Match Pace followed by goals to Erik Riquelme (87th) and Mitchell Allen (92nd).
- Next Sunday will see Gosford take on Wyoming in their local derby while Terrigal will be at home to Avoca in the Battle of the Beaches.

#### **BERKELEY VALE vs THE ENTRANCE**

- In the second Saturday night match a 15-minute three-goal onslaught midway through the second half has seen Berkeley Vale come from a one-nil down to defeat The Entrance 3-2 at Pat Morley Oval in the home club's traditional Travis Bragg Memorial charity match. The premiers' opening goal came in the 32nd minute from captain/coach Matt Page but the Sea

Eagles had no answer as Berkeley Vale hit back with goals to John Dineen-Griffin, Brad Thoseby between the 60th and 75th minute. The loss leaves The Entrance without a win in their first three matches while Berkeley Vale move into the top four with back-to-back wins.

### **KILLARNEY DISTRICT vs WYOMING**

- Killarney District have extended their 2016 unbeaten record across three competitions in emphatic style with a crushing 9-1 win over Wyoming. On the way the Terriers star striker Tim Knight has set a new Premier League individual goal scoring record with 7 goals. The Tigers already understrength defensive line was further weakened when they lost Andrew Watts early in the match and the speedy and skilful Killarney attack played havoc throughout the match. Todd Leach scored the home team's other two goals while Sam Dooley picked up a late consolation goal for Wyoming.
- Killarney now travel to Mount Druitt on Wednesday night for their Round 5 FFA match then take on Berkeley Vale at Mingara next Saturday night. Wyoming meet arch-rivals Gosford City at Alan Davidson Park on Sunday.

### **UMINA vs TOUKLEY**

- Toukley's dream start to their return to Premier League has continued with their third straight win, downing Umina 3-1 at Umina Oval. All goals came in the second half with Umina taking the lead from the penalty spot through French import Hugo Vidal-Membrado. Most of the action came in the last quarter of an hour of the match. In the 77th minute the Gunners equalised with Jai Kelly taking his tally to five but then missed the chance of a sixth with an unsuccessful penalty attempt, but crucially one that saw Umina's Todd Beckham receive a second yellow card. Toukley took full advantage with Mitch Harper scoring in the 89th minute and Troy Runge sealing the result deep into injury time.
- Next Monday (Anzac Day) will see the traditional Peninsula Derby between Umina and Southern-Ettalong at James Browne Oval. At the other end of the Coast Toukley will be looking to continue their unbeaten run when they meet struggling premiers, The Entrance, at Harry Moore Oval on Sunday.

### **AVOCA vs SOUTHERN-ETTALONG**

- Southern-Ettalong have picked up their first win of the season with a hard-fought 3-1 win over Avoca at Erina High School. The home team clearly adapted better to the slippery conditions in the first half, taking the lead through Shaun Izzard. Replacement SEU goalkeeper, Luke Carnovale, then kept his team in the match with two penalty saves. Rob Ward then equalised for the Lions to go to the break at 1-1. Coach Dale Eggleton's half-time talk saw Southern bounce back strongly in the second term and they took the lead through a Keith Gumbs penalty in the 75th minute followed five minutes later with James Caban clinching the win.
- Avoca now meet a very confident neighbour in Terrigal on Sunday at Duffys Oval. Southern play Umina on Anzac Day.
