SUMMARY

- Killarney District have extended their lead in the 2016 Battlewin Premier League competition to three points with their seventh win of the season with fellow top-four teams Toukley and Gosford City sharing the points in their match. Meanwhile The Entrance have finally kick-started their title defence with the 2014 and 2015 premiers picking up their first win of the season.

KILLARNEY DISTRICT vs AVOCA

- In an indication of the club's depth Killarney District remain unbeaten in all three grades with 17 wins and 7 draws from their 24 matches. With their inspirational leader Tim Knight rested to aid his recovery from injury the Terriers were made to fight throughout against a gutsy Avoca team with an early goal to Brendan Hall all that separated the two teams. With striker Shaun Izzard likely to miss the season Avoca were reinforced by the return of their English import, Nathan Watt who made such an impact last season for the Sharks.
- In a first-vs-last encounter Killarney travel to Umina Oval next Sunday but are unlikely to underestimate an increasingly desperate Umina team. Avoca will take on Gosford City at Gavenlock Oval.

TERRIGAL vs SOUTHERN-ETTALONG

- After a frustrating start to the season Southern-Ettalong is beginning to gain momentum with a second successive win, this time breaking Terrigal's five-match unbeaten run with a 1-0 win at Duffys Oval. The Lions win was all the more impressive in that they lost three players prior to kick-off and were forced into a last-minute re-structure. The only goal in the match came in the 16th minute through Lewis Murphy.
- Despite the loss Terrigal remain in third place with SEU moving up to fifth. Terrigal will have their second Saturday night match in three weeks when they meet Berkeley Vale at Mingara while Southern will also be on the road, playing The Entrance at Pat Morley Oval on Sunday.



GOSFORD CITY vs TOUKLEY

- The Match of the Round saw two of the early competition favourites, Gosford City and Toukley, play a 1-1 draw at Gavenlock Oval. Adam Woodbine gave the home team the lead in the 16th minute with Damien Lobb heading the equaliser from a corner kick just before the half-time break. Both teams missed scoring opportunities in the second half with a brilliant save by Jake Purches denying Gosford a late winner.
- It was the first Premier League match at Gavenlock Oval this season and, although it has finally dried out the ground isn't up to the standard required for this elite competition. Fortunately the venue is scheduled for an upgrade during summer. Gosford's next four games are at home starting with Avoca next Sunday, before a switch to Saturday night at Pluim against The Entrance the following round. Toukley take on Wyoming at Alan Davidson Park.

UMINA vs THE ENTRANCE

- For many years opposition teams dreaded the trip down to Umina Oval where the locals were all but unbeatable. That has changed since the ground was renovated and Umina has struggled in the past couple of seasons and the 5-2 win to The Entrance was no great surprise. The game was much closer than the final score indicates with Umina fighting back from 3-0 down to 3-2 with just 10 minutes to play before the Sea Eagles put away two late goals. In the absence of Terrie Dries, midfielder Zac Anastas grabbed the opportunity to play up front with a hat-trick between Jacob Jackson's early goal and Nathan Blundell's successful late free-kick. Shaun Conduit and Ben Scully-Hawkins were Umina's goal scorers.
- The loss leaves Umina in last place while The Entrance move out of the relegation zone for the first time this season. Umina have the tough task of beating competition leaders Killarney District at EDSACC North next Sunday while The Entrance will be looking to build some forward momentum when they host Southern-Ettalong.

BERKELEY VALE vs WYOMING

- Berkeley Vale has bounced back from their loss to Southern with a 2-1 win over Wyoming at Mingara Sports Field. But for some poor finishing the Wombats would have sealed the game after a dominant first half, as it was Wyoming fought back in an even second half before back-to-back goals to Troy Mumford and Simon Vella in the last 15 minutes looked to have settled the result. Wyoming almost snatched an unlikely point with Pat Mills scoring from the penalty spot and then narrowly missing from a scramble in front of the Berkeley goal.
- The crucial points move Berkeley Vale up to sixth place with a game in hand. Likewise Wyoming has a postponed game to play but have dropped back down into the relegation zone. Both teams have tough matches next week against newly-promoted opponents with Berkeley Vale hosting Terrigal on Saturday night and Wyoming taking on Toukley at Alan Davidson Park on Sunday.
