#### SUMMARY

- The Battlewin Premier League competition has finally resumed after a three-week break, one scheduled on the Long Weekend and two from inclement weather. The postponed Round 10 matches will now be played on the weekend of 9/10 July; while the Round 11 match have been moved to the weekend of 13/14 August. The two Round 5 matches (Avoca vs Wyoming and Gosford City vs Berkeley Vale) will now be played on Wednesday 20 July.
- Following the Round 12 matches, all of which were local derbies, there has been no change in the structure of the competition table. Killarney District have extended their lead to six points at the top of the table, with their ninth win from 10 matches while Terrigal has closed the gap on their fellow promoted rivals, Toukley to just three points. The four bottom placed teams were all beaten.

#### **BERKELEY VALE vs KILLARNEY DISTRICT**

- In a Saturday night match at a chilly Mingara Club field Killarney District have defeated traditional rivals Berkeley Vale 3-1. In an even first half the two teams traded goals with Brendan Hall giving Killarney the lead in the 25th minute and Troy Mumford equalising in the 35th for the Wombats. A goal to midfielder Nathan Stephenson, a late signing for Killarney after playing and coaching overseas, regained the lead for the visitors before a late own goal by Berkeley Vale settled the result.
- Berkeley Vale will be at home again next Saturday night against the rapidly improving The Entrance team while Killarney will travel to Alan Davidson Park to meet Wyoming.

#### **AVOCA vs TERRIGAL**

- In the round's second Saturday night match Terrigal were 6-1 winners over Avoca at Plum Park. The eventual scoreline didn't truly reflect the pattern of the match with Avoca on top for the first 20 minutes but Terrigal converting most of their chances. Fergus Worrall scored a hat-trick, including a late penalty which saw Avoca's goalkeeper red-carded. Jayden Priest, Scott Austin and Jack Regan were Terrigal's other goal scorers with Jake Elder on target for the Sharks.
- The win consolidates Terrigal's place in the top four and reduces the gap between them and second-placed Toukley to three points. It sets them up for the Match of the Round next

Sunday when they host Gosford City at Pluim Park. Avoca travel to the peninsula where they play Southern-Ettalong at James Browne Oval.

### **GOSFORD CITY vs WYOMING**

- Despite only winning 2-0 Gosford City was never threatened in their derby against Wyoming at Gavenlock Oval. Gosford led at half-time with former NPL player Louis Bozanic scoring his first BPL goal in the 39th minute. Adam Woodbine then extended the lead on the hour mark. The weakened Tigers team again showed that they won't surrender their place in the Premier League without a fight and defended stoutly throughout the match.
- Gosford will be looking to move into third place when they take on Terrigal at Pluim Park on Sunday while Wyoming will want to bury the ghost of their first round 9-1 loss to Killarney District at Alan Davidson Park.

### **THE ENTRANCE vs TOUKLEY**

- It's taken most of the first round but The Entrance's quest for a third straight premiership is now back on track with the Sea Eagles notching up their third win on a row, defeating second-placed Toukley 2-1 at Pat Morley Oval. The home team struck early with Tyson Adams finishing off two quality team goals before the midway point of the first half. Jai Kelly then pulled a goal back from the penalty spot for the Gunners just before the break.
- After sitting in last place after six matches the premiers have now moved up to sixth spot and will be keen to build their momentum against Berkeley Vale at Mingara next Saturday night. Toukley make the long trek south to Umina Oval anxious to return to winning form against last-placed Umina.

### **UMINA vs SOUTHERN-ETTALONG**

- Southern-Ettalong have notched up their fourth win of the season with a hard-fought 1-0 win in their traditional Peninsula Derby against Umina at Umina Oval. The only goal in the match came from James Caban midway through the first half.
- The win kept Southern in the top five with the never-relegated Umina still looking for their first points since Round 4. Both clubs are at home next Sunday, SEU playing Avoca and Umina up against Toukley.
