#### SUMMARY

- The scene has now been set for the finals series in the 2016 Battlewin Mens Premier League competition with all postponed matches being played over the past five days. The two deferred Round 5 matches finally went ahead - at the fourth attempt - in midweek with the five Round 11 wash-outs being played over the weekend. With 16 goals in two matches within two days Gosford City have emerged as the biggest threat to tearaway leaders Killarney District who have dropped points for the first time in 11 matches. The battle for fourth place will go into next week's final round with Terrigal hanging on to fourth place but facing a late challenge from The Entrance.
- With seven goals in his last four matches Gosford City's Adam Woodbine has emerged as a late contender for the 2016 Battlewin Golden Boot award. Although Killarney's Tim Knight (21 goals) remains odds-on to secure the prestigious trophy Woodbine (16) is now breathing down the neck of Toukley's Jai Kelly (17). Knight will be looking to either match or overhaul Brenton Olzomer's 2014 record of 22 goals in Killarney's final match against Avoca next Sunday.
- The composition of the top four in Division One has been decided with East Gosford and Kincumber due to play in the major semi-final (after a preview match next Sunday at Frost Reserve). Kanwal and Ourimbah will meet in the minor semi.
- The Entrance have wrapped up the Sea-FM Womens League league championship with a 3-1 win over Gosford City at Pat Morley Oval in the penultimate match of the competition. The two teams will meet again in the major semi-final in a fortnight with Killarney District and Umina to play in the minor semi.

### **GOSFORD CITY vs SOUTHERN-ETTALONG**

- Less than 48 hours after thrashing Berkeley Vale 9-2 on Thursday night at Pluim Park Gosford City have repeated the dose at the same venue with a 7-3 win over Southern-Ettalong. The Dragons could hardly have been more impressive scoring six goals in the first half although, as they did against the Wombats they took their foot off the throttle, allowing Southern to win the second half 2-1. Benji Gosson and Adam Woodbine repeated their braces from the Thursday night match with Reece Caira, Louis Bozanic and Josh Schumann all scoring first-half goals. Jeremy Phillips, Rob Ward and Nathan Nickolic scored for SEU.
- The two wins have moved the Dragons into second place although they will need at least a draw from their final match against third-place Toukley next Sunday at Harry Moore Oval to book a place in the major semi-final against Killarney District. Southern can have a say in the composition of the top four when they meet fourth-placed Terrigal at James Browne Oval.

### **KILLARNEY DISTRICT vs TERRIGAL**

- The first ever night Premier League match at EDSACC North has produced one of the most exciting matches of the season with Killarney District and Terrigal playing out a 3-3 draw. After a scoreless first half Terrigal set the Terriers on their heels with goals to Jayden Priest and Fergus Worrall within the first ten minutes of the restart. Killarney hit back strongly with a Terrigal own goal followed quickly by goals to Blake Silvers and Todd Leach to give their team a 3-2 lead. Terrigal then snatched a valuable point with Jai McNamara scoring in the final play of the match.
- Terrigal's hopes of playing in the final series in their first season back in Premier League now rest on two matches next Sunday. A win over Southern-Ettalong at James Browne Oval will guarantee fourth place however any other result will mean that they will be relying on Umina to either draw or win against The Entrance in that match at Pat Morley Oval.

### **AVOCA vs TOUKLEY**

- Toukley have bounced back from their big loss to Killarney District with a 2-0 win over Avoca at Pluim Park 2. An own goal by Avoca gave the Gunners the lead in the 26th minute with Brenton Westley sealing the win early in the second half.
- The result sets the scene for next week's second-decider between Toukley and the rampant Gosford City at Harry Moore Oval. A win for the hosts will see them overtake Gosford and secure the crucial Major semi-final spot. Avoca will meet Killarney District at Erina High School.

### **THE ENTRANCE vs WYOMING**

- The Entrance have kept their chances of making the finals series with a strong 4-0 win over Wyoming at Pat Morley Oval. The Sea Eagles had the match under control by the half-time break with goals to Nathan Blunden in the 20th minute followed by two further goals late in the half from Zac Anastas and Tyson Adams. A second to Adams after the break ensured that his team would carry what could be a crucial +3 goal difference advantage into the final round. The Entrance remain in fifth place but have closed the gap behind Terrigal to just two points. They will need to defeat Umina next Sunday and hope that Terrigal either lose or draw with Southern-Ettalong.
- After briefly getting off the bottom of the ladders courtesy of a late equaliser by Akem Yaak in their Wednesday night match against Avoca, Wyoming are back in possession of the

wooden spoon following Umina's win over Berkeley Vale. Their final fate rests on next Sunday's match against Berkeley Vale together with Umina's clash with The Entrance. Regardless of those results the two former Premier League powerhouses will be playing in the second-tier Division One competition next season.

### BERKELEY VALE vs UMINA

- Any time in the past 10 years a match between these two clubs at this time of year would have been a rehearsal for the upcoming premierships playoffs. Such has been the turnaround in the 2016 season that all that rested on the match was Umina's hopes of handing the wooden spoon to the other dominant club of the past decade, Wyoming, with Berkeley Vale certain to finish in third-last place. Playing their second match in four days didn't help the Wombats cause and they went behind in the 30th minute with a goal to Umina stalwart Jason Stafford. Umina will clearly be looking to youth over the next few years to restore the club's unmatched Premier League record so their second goal, to 16-year-old Jack Keenan, was a promising sign.
- Both Berkeley Vale and Wyoming will be reminiscing about past glories when they meet at Alan Davidson Park next Sunday while Umina will be out to spoil The Entrance's hopes of a third straight premiership at Pat Morley.
