Communication

MyComApp is the source for all things football throughout the season. The website/app will give you access to team sheets, fixtures, ground closures, results and notifications.

The club's main form of communication outgoing are club socials (Facebook and Instagram) and MyCompApp. Incoming communication can be made via club socials, website or email.

Training

Training nights are Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Training allocations have been provided to coaches and managers. All teams need to stay within their allocated slots on the oval, and within their allocated times.

Canteen

Our canteen is operated by Di and Jan, with support from the club committee and other volunteers.

Throughout the season, all teams are scheduled onto BBQ duty for 30min-60min blocks depending on the age group before their game on weekends. It is important for teams to send 2-3 volunteers to these allocated slots. Each team will be scheduled several times throughout the season.



Field Set Up/ Pack Up

The first team on each field each home gameday will be required to set up the field each weekend. Field setup needs to occur 45min before kick off. Field setup includes corner flags, nets/goals and benches (benches for U12 and up only).

Field pack up is completed by the last team on the field each home gameday. Field pack up includes packing away of corner flags, nets/goals and benches.

The teams allocated to field set up and pack up will be advised via MyCompApp prior to each gameday.

Referee Fees

Referee fees for Under 5's – Under 18's and Division 1 are included in player registration fees. For Men's and Women's All Age and Over 35 and Over 45 teams, referee fees are to be paid on a weekly basis pending what referees are assigned to each game. Referee fees will need to be paid at the canteen within 2 weeks otherwise teams will risk forfeiting games until fees are paid. Referee fees for Season 2024 are as follows.

- Centre Referee - \$37.50
- Line Ref 1 - \$18.75
- Line Ref 2 - \$18.75

This means a game with a centre and both linesmen would cost the team \$75.

Field Closures

Monday to Friday Central Coast Council assess Harry Moore Oval for suitability of training. Ground status (i.e. open/closed) is updated on Councils website (<https://www.centralcoast.nsw.gov.au/recreation/sports/sportsgrounds>) by 2pm on weekdays. The club will only post via club socials and/or MyCompApp if the ground is **CLOSED** for training (i.e. assume the ground is OPEN and training is on unless informed otherwise by the club by 2.30pm).

On weekends the club assess Harry Moore Oval for suitability for games based on a criteria set by Council. Any ground closures are reported to CCF. Ground closures for the weekend can be viewed on the public website (<https://ccf.mycompapp.com/#/fields>) and are sent as a notification via MyCompApp.
